Our Warwickshire will celebrate and promote access to heritage within Warwickshire communities, as well as significantly improving the experience for visitors to Market Hall Museum, Warwick. It will also offer a new online platform enabling communities beyond Warwick to share and celebrate their heritage.

The physical improvements, including changes to the layout, display and interpretation at Market Hall will be complemented by an online gateway to celebrate and share Warwickshire's heritage even further. By harnessing the power of social media and online platforms, the project will ensure engagement goes far beyond local audiences and visitors and has worldwide potential. Driven by communities, enthusiasts from across the county will be able to upload content, share their stories, organise events and encourage others to take part and get involved.

Reyahn King, Head of Heritage Lottery Fund West Midlands, said: "Our Warwickshire promises to transform the way people can explore the county's rich heritage, from interactive new exhibitions and community space to an innovative online platform where people can share their own stories.
