Members will have opportunities to meet inspiring people involved in projects and will also represent HLF at openings and events, acting as a champion for the value of heritage to modern life.

HLF support in Yorkshire and the Humber has supported a vast array of projects over the past 21 years, investing over £470m to nearly 3,300 heritage projects which have supported and contributed to communities, regeneration, tourism and the economy and which have helped to look after and open up our heritage for everyone to enjoy.

We welcome interest from people with a range of backgrounds and experiences who can demonstrate that they can apply their skills to, and have enthusiasm for, this role.

The role offers an interesting and wonderful personal development opportunity which has provided some of our younger members with transferable skills to help further their careers.
