The project will also involve urgent work required to the church nave and transepts. This includes replacement of RWP's repairs to north parapets, installation of ladder for roof access from the tower window, replace duckboards and gullies for surface water drainage and polycarbonate replacement to Lady Chapel stained glass. The urgent need to carry out the works as identified has been confirmed and the church remains in a poor condition. The project will remove the church from the Hertiage at Risk register.
